Dear parents and students,

As you may be aware IES Breckland was visited by Ofsted on the 19th and 20th November. This was a two day monitoring visit to ascertain whether the school is making progress, rather than a full inspection.

The status of a school cannot be changed during a monitoring visit and a school cannot be taken out of special measures. There are two judgements available - a school can be found to be making reasonable progress or not making reasonable progress towards the removal of special measures.

I am pleased to say that as a result of the hard work and support of students, staff, parents and the wider community the report by Her Majesty's Inspector Chris Moodie found that: "The school is making reasonable progress towards the removal of special measures."

Everyone involved should feel proud of their part in achieving this judgement. However, it is just another step forward and we will maintain our efforts to ensure that our school continues to improve.

The tangible improvements that have been made at IES Breckland since February have been recognised by Ofsted and all stakeholders are committed to providing a high standard of education for all of our students.
